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**Audio recording of telephone
call with Chelsea Ward**

Q&A	Description
Mr. Gish	So SNARL received communication from some California rescues begging for help, that there were some dogs abandoned in the middle of the desert outside of Barstow.
Officer	Do you know what rescues those were?
Mr. Gish	I don't personally know but I'm not going to disclose that anyway even if I did.
Officer	Okay.
Mr. Gish	Oh, I'm sorry, you want me to continue?
Officer	Umm, just taking notes so I appreciate it. So you received communication from several rescues and then how did you, then what happened?
Mr. Gish	So SNARL received the communication, I didn't, but so SNARL then sent representatives out from Vegas to somewhere in Barstow, somewhere in Barstow from, I think it was uh, I think they all met up in a parking lot at a bar outside Barstow and the rescues then transferred dogs to SNARL. I would also like to add that the way this all came about was that a, a -- umm, a -- you're going to have to hold on a second.
	[Someone whispers: "Oh, he's already said it."]
Mr. Gish	So the way this came about is that a government whistleblower employed by San Bernardino County contacted certain California rescues and asked for their assistance in rescuing German Shepherd dogs that were left abandoned in the middle of the desert outside Barstow. Once the rescuers arrived at the site they were instructed by the California, or the San Bernardino County employee whistleblower. She entered the land and removed the rescue.
Officer	So you say San Bernardino County and....
Mr. Gish	Removed the dogs, removed the dogs.
Officer	You say San Bernardino County employee. Do you know what agency they worked for for San Bernardino County?
Mr. Gish	Yes I do, but I'm not going to disclose that.
Officer	Okay.

Mr. Gish	Here, I've looked at the one, I believed they'd be protected as though government whistleblower under California law.
Officer	Okay.
Mr. Gish	And so I'm not prepared to disclose that person's name, rank or what their agency was.
Officer	So you don't know if they worked for Animal Control or the Sheriff's Department.
Mr. Gish	Again, I'm not going to answer that question.
Officer	All right, I had to try. So San Bernardino County employee calls, they get into communication with other rescues, other rescues come out to the property, you guys, nobody from SNARL actually made it out to the property, they all met at the bar and animals were exchanged at the bar. Is that a correct understanding?
Mr. Gish	That's absolutely correct. SNARL's never been to the property, has no idea where it's even at.
Officer	How many dogs did SNARL take possession of?
Mr. Gish	We're a little unsure on that.
Officer	Ball park? I've heard different numbers, I've heard 25.
Mr. Gish	What's the ball park? 20 ball park.
Officer	20, okay. And now, what happened to those 20 dogs?
Mr. Gish	They've been, they've been adopted out.
Officer	All 20 of them?
Mr. Gish	Yes. SNARL has possession of none of the dogs. Mental or physical.
Officer	So from reading on your guy's website it looks like you use a foster system where you guys...

Mr. Gish	These dogs were not -- like I said, SNARL has no legal or physical custody of any of these dogs. They stayed, or if they were being fostered, they would still be _____ legal _____.
Officer	Okay, do you guys have documentation of where these dogs went?
Mr. Gish	Of course.
Officer	Okay, would you be willing to provide that information to us?
Mr. Gish	Absolutely not.
Officer	Okay. It's all good.
Mr. Gish	And actually you know what, maybe I should revise that prior, that prior answer. I don't have any personal knowledge of any documentation, that was just an assumption on my part.
Officer	So you're not sure if SNARL has documentation of where they would foster or give their dogs away to...
Mr. Gish	I don't know if they have that, that was an assumption on my part. But the dogs have all been adopted out.
Officer	Okay.
Mr. Gish	Or turned over to other rescues.
Officer	And you work as an attorney full time and you are, you help them pro bono? or you're their hired attorney? What kind of law do you normally practice?
Mr. Gish	I'm a full-time attorney here in Las Vegas and I'm helping them out pro bono on this case.
Officer	What kind of law do you normally practice?
Mr. Gish	Civil litigation.
Officer	And what law firm do you work for?
Mr. Gish	Law Office of Casey Gish.
Officer	And your address for your law firm?

Mr. Gish	████ South Rainbow Boulevard, Las Vegas, Nevada 89118.
Officer	You said Rainbow Boulevard right? South Rainbow Boulevard?
Mr. Gish	Correct. Correct.
Officer	Las Vegas, Nevada and then 8-9 sorry, one more time on the zip code?
Mr. Gish	89118.
Officer	And is there a physical address for SNARL?
Mr. Gish	No.
Officer	It shows that there is some sort of warehouse. Is there -- I'm reading through the post that there is a rescue center. Is there no address for that facility?
Mr. Gish	I'm not sure what you're looking at but SNARL doesn't have a physical location.
Officer	I was reading a post on the Facebook. Let me see if I can find it again. They were asking for like cat food and kitty litter. They said the Rescue has over 100 cats and they're running low on that...
Mr. Gish	You've got to hold on, I've got --- my business is going crazy right now...
Officer	I'm sorry. I do appreciate you taking the time to speak with me.
Mr. Gish	All right, any other questions because I've got a go, because I've got all kinds of people here waiting for me and so I've got to go.
Officer	Is there no address for that, for a rescue?
Mr. Gish	There's no address for the rescue other than I imagine they're personal residents.
Officer	Because on August 11 th it says we have a large need for cat litter and kitten food; you know, in the rescue currently we have nearly over a 140 cats.
Mr. Gish	Those are probably being fostered.
Officer	But it says that they have been in one location, at least that's how it reads. And they're asking for people...

Mr. Gish	I don't know, Chelsea can you shed any light on that?
Officer	...people to go on to...
Chelsea	I have to, I'd have to, yeah, I'd have to go back in and look at the actual post that now it's in. People are sending the clients from Amazon to us, it's shipped either directly to my residence or it's shipped to our storage unit. But it's just a regular like storage unit, it's not, we don't have any animals there. Or mailing out trucks or anything.
Officer	Okay, so there's no actual shelter or rescue center, it is all through foster?
Chelsea	That's correct, yeah, we're a hundred percent foster-based other than dogs that we have in boarding or boarding partnerships that [inaudible].
Officer	So that you guys got the 20 dogs? From Hinckley you were able to quickly arrange foster or how did those get moved?
Mr. Gish	So let me answer that Chelsea. They were, they were put in to, for the most part they were put into bad situations because they were in terrible condition.
Officer	Okay. And Chelsea, can I get your name and your last name?
Chelsea	As in Tom...
Officer	The phone broke up, I'm sorry.
Chelsea	It's Chelsea and last name is Moore, M-o-o-r-e.
Officer	Okay, and your address?
Chelsea	My home address is [REDACTED] Avenue, that's North Las Vegas, Nevada 89031.
Officer	8-9-0...
Chelsea	0-3-1. Yes.
Officer	And that's North Las Vegas?
Chelsea	Correct.
Officer	Okay and the phone number I called you at, [REDACTED] ?

Chelsea	Yes, correct.
Officer	And your birthday?
Chelsea	██████████.
Mr. Gish	I'd also like to add that these people that kept these dogs in hellish conditions are now harassing SNARL and other rescuers including coming to their houses, their private residence uninvited, coming to their businesses nonstop, threatening emails, that just --- and we're just trying to help dogs in there.
Officer	Has that been reported to the local law enforcement out there?
Mr. Gish	It has, it has, and also restraining orders are pending.
Officer	Okay, like I said, we're not on anybody's side here, we just gather information so if there's wrongdoing out...
Mr. Gish	_____ understand how we feel that we got, the original rescues were asked by government officials in San Bernardino County to become involved in this and help these dogs. We were then asked by those rescues to help these dogs. And now we've got police reports filed against us, we're being personally harassed at home and all we ever wanted to do was just protect an animal that were living in hellish condition.
Officer	I understand that. I hope you don't feel like I'm harassing you. We're, we are trying to figure out as much as we can so we can do what's right by...
Mr. Gish	I'm sorry, and you know, I mean I'm probably coming across as a little bit of a jerk, it's just the situation, yeah, I guess no good deed goes unpunished and when these people are contacting me around the clock for the last over two weeks by sending threatening emails to me and phone calls. Maybe I've got a little bit of _____ mentality at this point.
Officer	Who's been calling you?
Mr. Gish	[Inaudible] for that.
Officer	Who, who's been calling you?

Mr. Gish	Umm, the lawyer, her lawyer and then also her -- just nonstop emails from her.
Officer	And who is "her"?
Mr. Gish	Umm, I --- what's her name?
Chelsea	It's Alla Zorikova and Olivia Jeong, I think they're who's sending us the massive email. And the attorney is calling at like 2:00 a.m. in the morning.
Officer	Who's the attorney?
Chelsea Moore	John...
Mr. Gish	John Levine, L-e-v-i-n-e.
Officer	Spell the last name one more time?
Mr. Gish	L-e-v as in Victor, I-n as in Nancy-e.
Officer	I'm sorry, L-e-v-i-n-e?
Mr. Gish	Yes.
Officer	All right, I'm sorry. Did you guys take photos of the dogs or do you have any documentation when you collected them?
Mr. Gish	We do. We didn't collect them, we received photos from the original California rescuers and we also received videos of the terrible conditions they were being held there.
Officer	Are there any photos from where you guys picked them up? Like did you guys photo them when you took possession of them at the bar?
Mr. Gish	No, it was like in the middle of the night I believe.
Officer	Okay. Is there anybody we can get the photos?
Mr. Gish	Umm...
Officer	If we had photos -- did you guys have photos of the conditions of the, like the way they were being kept or housed? Those could...

Mr. Gish	We have photos, we have videos and we are actually _____ in the process of drafting letters to the District Attorney there in San Bernardino County compiling all the evidence, all the vet records, the terrible conditions these dogs are in.
Officer	Because if you guys -- so we have an open case with the District Attorney. It was initially turned down, that's what I think has been told or is being said, that happens commonly with cases or the District Attorney wants additional information. They're asking for vet records.
Mr. Gish	Yes, so basically what we're doing, what we spent the last week doing is compiling all the evidence that the District Attorney asked for in the memo to you guys when she dropped the charges. And we're compiling as much information as we can to support the filing of those charges including videos, vet records, photograph, and your office is actually going to get a copy of the letter as well.
Officer	Can you email me that?
Mr. Gish	It's not quite finished yet. We're hoping to finish it in the next day or two.
Officer	At its completion though, that way I can add it to the criminal case and I can get it sent to the District Attorney. Because it, like we said, we have...
Mr. Gish	[Inaudible] we're going to be addressed, we're going to sent a letter to the State Attorney General and also the FBI as well under the new Federal Anti-_____ laws. And so, and also we've got a couple of media channels here in Vegas that are interested in the story.
Officer	All right. But there's no way you could email me that stuff so I could get it to our District Attorney because our District Attorney is reviewing the case and all of that information can...
Mr. Gish	Yes, we're going to get, like I said, I'm going to send it to you to the District Attorney hopefully in the next day or two and then you'll get a copy as well.
Officer	Okay. Would you like my email?
Mr. Gish	Uh, can you send me an email? Right now?
Officer	Sure, give me yours and I'll send one to you.
